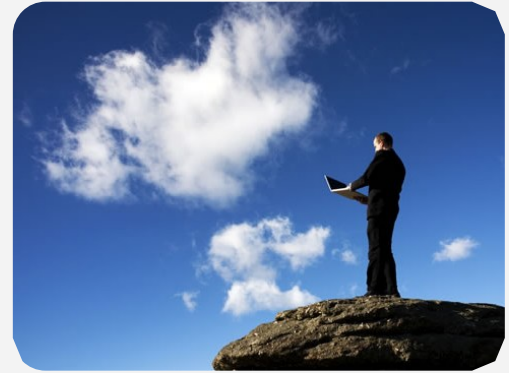


Cloud Computing Overview
