Production Alarming System (ANDON)

Overview


A Production Alarming System (Andon) highlights operators' requests for assistance using both visual and audible signals. The purpose of the Andon is to enhance work group communication so that quality defects are corrected within the station before it causes issues with subsequent operations, causes a major repair or gets to the customer.

The Andon system consists of operator switched devices that activate visual and audible alerts, standard workstation markings, and Fixed Position Line Stop (FPLS) controls. Status of team stations can be displayed on marquees, email, pagers, through use of the Middleware Suite. When the stack lights are activated, the operations team are instantly made aware of costly conditions occurring on the plant floor such as "materials low / out", "maintenance required" or a "supervisor request".
